## Avon Walk for Breast Cancer Boston May 15 - 16, 2010

Here's a list of the best locations for friends and family to safely cheer on Walkers along the route. Please be a courteous neighbor, leave the Cheering Station as clean as you found it and obey all traffic rules so that we'll be invited back next year. And don't forget to bring your Avon Walk flair, posters, music, etc.! This is your time to have fun while supporting a great cause!

### **SATURDAY – MAY 15, 2010**

#### **Curley Community Center (Mile 2.42)**

1663 Columbia Road, South Boston, MA 02127

Peak viewing times: 7:15am-8:30am

Directions: Cheering Station is located right by the beach in front of the Center on the grassy patch by the M Street Entrance, in front of the Community section of the building.

Notes: This is the very first Cheering Station of the Avon Walk Boston! Be sure to take a walk down the boardwalk after cheering!

#### **Boston Public Garden (Mile 7.95)**

Charles Street & Beacon Street, Boston, MA 02108

Peak viewing times: 8:45am-11:30am

Directions: Cheering Station is inside the Public Garden near the Charles Street and Beacon Street intersection. The nearest MBTA is Arlington Station.

Notes: What an iconic spot to cheer the Walkers on as they enjoy the beautiful scenery! Be sure to check out the Make Way for Ducklings statues after you cheer!

#### **City of Boston Fire Department Monument (Mile 9.60)**

Fenway & Westland Street, Boston, MA 02115

Peak viewing times: 9:15am-12:00pm

Directions: Cheering Station is located outside the stone building. The nearest MBTA is Northeastern Station or Symphony Station. Several paid parking lots are available near Symphony Hall.

Notes: This monument celebrates Boston's firefighters. Celebrate the Walkers by keeping their motivation high. There is plenty of space for lawn chairs and room to run around – bring the kids!

**Emmanuel College (Mile 10.20)**

3 Avenue Louis Pasteur, Boston, MA 02155

Peak viewing times: 9:30am-12:30pm

Directions: Cheering Station is on the grassy area in front of Emmanuel College's Cardinal Cushing Library. Paid parking available in the Landmark Center or the nearest MBTA is Fenway Station.

Notes: From the corner of Fenway and Avenue Louis Pasteur you can greet the Walkers before they head to lunch. Pack a picnic lunch to enjoy in the Fens when all the Walkers are passing by!

**The Park School (Mile 12.90)**

171 Goddard Street, Brookline, MA 02445

Peak viewing times: 10:15am-2:30pm

Directions: Cheering Station is in front of the school near the trees and stone wall.

Notes: This spot is a chance for you to spread out and congratulate Walkers on making it up the hill! They are starting to get tired so we need you to cheer them on! Just a little further to lunch!

**Chestnut Hill Hair Fashions (Mile 16.70)**

440 Baker Street, West Roxbury, MA 02132

Peak viewing times: 11:00am-3:30pm

Directions: Cheering Station is located on the big paved area in front of the building. Parking is available on the side streets nearby.

Notes: Wear some bright color fashions so Walkers can see you straight ahead before they even get there! Lots of dancing room here!

**Readville Commuter Rail (Mile 23.40)**

1800 Hyde Park Avenue, Hyde Park, MA 02136

Peak viewing times: 12:30pm-5:30pm

Directions: Cheering Station is by the Readville Commuter Rail sign either at Hyde Park Avenue and Milton Street intersection or by Readville Commuter Rail sign on Hyde Park Avenue. Please use paid parking available in commuter lot for \$4. This Cheering Station is also convenient to several buses.

Notes: At 23 miles, the Walkers need as much energy as you can give! They are in the home stretch!

**Thatcher Montessori School (Mile 25.15)**

1425 Blue Hill Avenue, Milton, MA 02186

Peak viewing times: 1:00pm-6:30pm

Directions: Cheering Station is located directly past Fuller Village on Blue Hill Avenue. It is bright blue with white trim. Parking is available in the school lot.

Notes: The Walkers are almost there; motivate them to finish their marathon journey for Saturday! Go Walkers Go!!!

**SUNDAY – MAY 16, 2010****Blue Hills Ski Area (Mile 1.10)**

4001 Washington Street (Route 138), Canton, MA 02021

Peak viewing times: 7:30am-9:00am

Directions: Cheering Station is located right off Route 138. Parking is available for Volunteers, family and friends in the Blue Hills parking lot.

Notes: Get a slope-side view of Walkers embarking on their second day of walking! They will need your energy to get warmed up and start the day off right!

**Butler MBTA Stop (Mile 7.8)**

34 Butler Street, Dorchester, MA 02124

Peak viewing times: 9:15am-12:45pm

Directions: Cheering Station is by the Neponset Trail and Butler MBTA parking lot. Just step of the Red Line at Butler and you're there!

Notes: Encourage the Walkers to enjoy the trail on their way! They are more than halfway to the end of their Sunday journey.

**Keystone Apartments (Mile 8.85)**

151 Hallet Street, Dorchester Center, MA 02124

Peak viewing times: 9:30am-1:00pm

Directions: Cheering Station is on the grass beside the Neponset Trail. Park nearby at the Pope John Paul Park, just a 2 minute walk on Hallet Street.

Notes: The key to motivating the Avon Walkers is to cheer, cheer, cheer!!! Feel free to bring your lawn chairs and LOTS of enthusiasm as there is plenty of room to spread out at this Cheering Station.

**Neponset Trail Finish (Mile 10.50)**

Water Street & Taylor Street Intersection, Dorchester, MA 02122

Peak viewing times: 10:00am-2:00pm

Directions: Cheering Station is located at the intersection of Water Street and Taylor Street. Parking is available on many of the nearby side streets.

Notes: This quiet road needs some spirit after Walkers have been on the trail for a while and exit here to the street. Wear bright colors or silly outfits to keep the Walkers motivated and smiling!

**Phillip's Candy House (Mile 11.18)**

818 William T Morrissey Boulevard, Dorchester, MA 02122

Peak viewing times: 10:15am-2:00pm

Directions: Cheering Station is located in front of the building. Candy lovers may be shopping so please save those prime parking spots for customers. You can find plenty of parking just around the side of the building.

Notes: Who doesn't love chocolate and sweets? Treat yourself to some delicious gourmet candy and cheer on the Walkers at the same time! They are almost done – give them a TON of encouragement to get through the last two miles!

**Fox Point Dock At UMass Boston (Mile 12.59)**

100 Morrissey Boulevard, Dorchester, MA 02125

Peak viewing times: 10:30am-2:15pm

Directions: Cheering Station is located inside the UMass Boston campus along the water, by the dock and boat launch, between the McCormack and Wheatley buildings facing the water.

Notes: This is the last Cheering Station before the end of the route. Come cheer on the Walkers and congratulate them as they make it through the last mile!
