WHAT TO DO ONCE YOU ARRIVE:

When you arrive at the Wellness Village site you want to go straight to the white **Visitor Check-In Tent** located in Sponsor Row (row of white tents). You will then sign-in and be directed to your station. **Tent Angels** will train with the Crew Gear & Tent Team. **Alumni Button Tent** Volunteers will work closely with the Volunteer Coordinator.

WHAT TO BRING:

There won't be any secure storage available, so it's best to bring a small bag that you can easily keep with you. There will be many people flowing in and out of the area, so please do not bring anything valuable as we cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items. We will have snacks and water (please bring your own water bottle) available on Saturday afternoon. Dinner will not be served. We will not have snacks or breakfast available on Sunday morning, but we have plenty of water to please bring your water bottle and eat before you come!

WHAT TO WEAR:

Dress comfortably. You will be receiving one volunteer t-shirt to wear during your shift. This Event will happen

BY CAR:

From the East:

- Take I-5S
- Take exit 172 for Newhall Ranch Rd/ 126 W toward Ventura
- Turn right at CA-126 W
- Stay on CA-126 W for about 40 miles
- Merge onto US-101N
- Exit Padaro Lane
- Right onto Padaro Lane
- Right Via Real
- Left into Santa Barbara Polo and Racquet Club

From the North:

- Take Highway US-101 S
- Exit Padaro Lane
- Left onto Padaro Lane
- Right Via Real
- Left into Santa Barbara Polo and Racquet Club

From the South:

- Take Highway US- 101 N
- Exit Padaro Lane
- Right onto Padaro Lane
- Right Via Real
- Left into Santa Barbara Polo and Racquet Club

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

Santa Barbara Polo and Racquet Club is easily accessible by public transportation. There is a city bus stop across the street from the club that services the Carpinteria (bus 20) line. For information regarding the city bus stops, contact 805-963-3366 or visit <http://www.sbmttd.gov/>.

For Volunteers coming from the Los Angeles area: Santa Barbara and Carpinteria both have Amtrak Stations that are located along the bus line. For information regarding Amtrak services, visit www.amtrak.com. There is also an Airbus from LAX to Santa Barbara. This shuttle drops off at the Hotel Mar Monte which is accessible via the bus line. From there, friends and family can take public transportation to the Polo and Racquet Club.
